- Distributed \$237,000 in down payment assistance through Federal Home Loan Bank
- Provided \$2,310,000 in funding for construction of 77 new homes through Colorado
 Division of Housing
- Facilitated **\$3.1 million** in mortgage sales through partnerships with **FirstBank** and **Colorado Housing and Finance Authority**
- Secured \$36,000 in corporate and foundation support for direct assistance to affiliates
- Renewed statewide product donations from Bryant Colorado, providing 46 new, energy-efficient furnaces and partnering with the Colorado Roofing Association and it's members to install 31 roofs with product donated by GAF
- Supported the needs of rural affiliates by providing over \$46,000 in direct financial assistance through United States Department of Agriculture, Rural Community Development Initiative funding



- Hosted 10 affiliate networking meetings engaging 96 participants from 34 affiliates
- Offered 8 webinar trainings with 131 attendees

ADVOCACY



- Actively supported two successful bills, HB23-1184 Low-Income Housing Property Tax
 Exemption and SB23-001 Authority Of Public-Private Collaboration Unit For Housing
- Monitored and provided amendments for SB23-213 Land Use legislation
- · Advocating resulted in over \$12 million in state funding allocations for individual affiliates
- Hosted Coffee at the Capitol in March to communicate Habitat's priorities with state
 legislators and held Difference Maker Builds in partnership with 8 affiliates in September,
 inviting local, state and federal government staff and elected officials to participate in a build
- Presented at the Colorado Municipal League's annual conference, Innovations in Affordable Homeownership, in partnership with HFH of Metro Denver, HFH of the St. Vrain Valley, and HFH Vail Valley

REVOLVING LOAN FUND

- Increased HFHC's Revolving Loan Fund with a total investment of \$3 million from the Colorado Housing and Finance Authority
